Hollywood Cinema Production Resources' Training Program provides industry-specific training in trade skills to individuals in what is expected of an entry-level person in the crafts and technicians areas of film and television.

Hollywood CPR's training program provides qualified students a unique opportunity to learn these specialized craft and trade skills from the industry professionals who are masters in their trade.

The classes offered cover a broad spectrum of the entertainment industry's art department and stage crafts needs, focusing on the most important and common skill applications expected of an entry-level worker.

Hollywood CPR's training program also incorporates broad-based life skills coaching and support that focus' on the myriad of social skills necessary for success in gaining and keeping employment.

Students can earn high school and college credit and an Entertainment Artist, Craft & Technician Certificate (through a collaboration with *West Los Angeles College*).

Hollywood CPR encourages and supports students working while attending classes, and credit is earned for working (if in field of training). **Successful graduates of Hollywood CPR's program can qualify as IATSE union permits.**

REQUIREMENTS

You must be at least 18 years of age for the career track (17 ½ and in High School okay) and 15-18 for the afterschool program, have a valid California Drivers License or valid California ID, and a valid Social Security Card.

We are looking for candidates who are passionate about learning one of the trades within the art department and other crafts of the film and television industry. Most of the jobs are physically demanding, so make sure you are up to the challenge!

Application process:

- 1) You must register online** to attend an orientation to get an application. (www.hollywoodcpr.org) Orientations are quarterly, are announced on our web site and held at Hollywood CPR's main facility at 9700 S. Sepulveda Blvd. enter on 98th St.
- 2) Complete the application** and return by the deadline with all attachments
- 3) If your application meets the criteria**, an interview will be scheduled with Hollywood CPR, and then you will be notified if accepted into the program.

Priority for acceptance into our program is reserved for youth who come from historically under-represented, economically disadvantaged areas of Los Angeles, and who demonstrate passion and commitment to the crafts of the entertainment industry.
